Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the admission committee based on a holistic review of the admission application and admission interview. HOW TO APPLY

To be considered for scholarships at the time of admission, complete the [Scholarship Essay on the Essay section of the online admission application](#). This uploaded essay will signal to the committee that you would like to be considered for all scholarships that you might qualify for.

IT PAYS TO APPLY EARLY

Scholarship awards limited. Our **priority scholarship deadline is March 31, 2021**. This means that the SMU Cox Executive MBA Program will award the majority of our scholarship awards to applicants who submit their online applications on or before this date. Admission Decisions and scholarship notifications are awarded on a rolling basis, about 2 weeks after you submit your application, you will also have your decision.

Qualified admitted students can only be awarded one scholarship at the time of admission (multiple scholarships are not awarded or combined). The type of scholarship is selected at the discretion of the admission committee. The entire scholarship award is applied towards tuition in the first year.

SMU Cox Executive MBA Scholarships are listed below:

- **The SMU Cox Executive MBA Scholarship**
Up to \$15,000. Eligibility: any applicant
- **The SMU Cox Executive MBA Forté Scholarship**
Up to \$15,000. Available in partnership with the Forté Foundation. Eligibility: female applicants
- **The SMU Cox Executive MBA Military Service Scholarship**
Up to \$15,000. Eligibility: applicants who are US veterans or active duty service members
- **The SMU Cox Executive MBA Community Leadership Scholarship**
Up to \$10,000. Eligibility: applicants who work for or are active members of non-profit organizations*
- **The SMU Cox Executive MBA Commerce Scholarship**
Up to \$5,000. Eligibility: applicants who are active members of a regional Chamber of Commerce.
- **The SMU Cox Executive MBA Homecoming Scholarship**
Up to \$5,000. Eligibility: applicants who have completed previous study at SMU. This includes but is not limited to, undergraduate study, previous graduate study, executive education programs and certificates, courses through continuing and professional education.

Second Year Scholarship - **The Stacy Heath Memorial Scholarship**

\$5,000 Award. In memory of EMBA student Stacy Heath. This scholarship is awarded to a second year student who will carry the memory of Stacy with them across the stage at graduation.

*Examples of community non-profit organizations can include but are not limited to: Holding public office, Rotary, Lions, American Legion, The Junior League, religious organizations, charitable boards, school boards, educational non-profits, health advocacy groups ect.
